### Dear Colleagues,

Welcome to the 6th International Meeting on Pulmonary Rare Diseases and Orphan Drugs and welcome in Milano, the EXPO City 2015 (May 1st and October 31st), where more than 20 million visitors are expected from all over the world to explore the theme "Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life", a topic of great importance for the future of our lives and for world health.

The first International Meeting on Pulmonary Rare Diseases and Orphan Drugs was held in 2005; since then, the Meeting has taken place regularly every 2 years, with growing success and ever increasing numbers of participants and speakers from around the world. This year more than 230 participants coming from 11 different countries are attending.

The International Meeting on Pulmonary Rare Diseases and Orphan Drugs, this year endorsed by the European respiratory Society, is the only European event dedicated to different types of rare pulmonary diseases affecting both parenchymal and vascular structures. In recent years, the interest for rare diseases has grown throughout the entire medical community, and many respiratory physicians were pioneers in this field of medicine.

The 6th International Meeting on Pulmonary Rare Diseases and Orphan Drugs goes further in this direction, highlighting that rare diseases represent an important field of medicine not only for pulmonologists who are skilled in diagnosing and treating particular groups of these illnesses but for all respiratory physicians.

Proceedings from past annual meetings and several selected reports from the 2013 and 2011 meetings have previously been published in the *European Respiratory Review*. Also this year some selected manuscripts from the 2015 conference will published in the September issue of the *Review*. In addition, the *European Respiratory Journal* will host a series of articles from the conference that will discuss rare pulmonary diseases and orphan drugs and cover different topics (e.g. IPF, LAM, PAH, pulmonary veno-occlusive disease...).

Knowledge exchange and dissemination among experts on different areas of clinical and basic research in respiratory medicine, with different specialized pulmonary medicine expertise (from vascular to interstitial lung diseases), is part of the stimulating challenge of providing new insights into science and clinical care, thus helping patients and supporting doctors.

We would like to thank the whole faculty, the sponsors and the participants for their support and enthusiasm.

For the 6th International Meeting on Pulmonary Rare Diseases and Orphan Drugs, we have decided to paraphrase the EXPO motto and adopt our own guiding motto: "Feeding the breath, Energy for life!".
